Three Dead After Middle TN Plane Crash

ville, Kentucky, broke apart mid-flight, as disclosed by Williamson County Chief Deputy Mark Elrod. The crash occurred around noon, with the debris field extending approximately half a mile. Williamson County Fire/Rescue reported the incident on Facebook, specifying the crash site near Bending Chestnut Road and Davis Hollow Road, close to the Natchez Trace Parkway. A 911 call at 12:05 p.m. alerted authorities to the crash, though details were limited. Audio from Air Traffic Control discussed the plane starting to descend from 9,000 feet. It talked about the plane having options to land 16 miles north. Its last communication to the plane was that air traffic controllers saw the plane heading back south. The control tower kept trying to reach the plane — it's not clear how the pilot responded from the audio. Hickman County Man Arrested, Charged with Homicide



An investigation by special agents with the Tennessee Bureau of Investigation (TBI) into the shooting death of one man and injuries to another person in Hickman County has resulted in the arrest of a Bon Aqua man.

On Wednesday, May 15th, at the request of 32nd Judicial District Attorney General Hans Schwendimann, TBI agents responded to a report of a shooting at a residence on Wayne Road in Bon Aqua. Initial reports indicate the incident began with an altercation between a juvenile and a young adult male, and the homeowner, Danny Pewitt, on that property. During that altercation, a motorist, Clair Parish, was flagged down and stopped at that location. At some point during the altercation, the specifics of which remain under investigation, Pewitt fired a weapon, striking and killing Parish and wounding the juvenile. The juvenile was transported to an area hospital for treatment and has since been released.

On Wednesday, agents arrested Danny Edward Pewitt. He is charged with one count of Criminal Homicide, and was booked into the Hickman County Jail. The investigation remains ongoing.
