# Three Victims Identified in Middle TN Plane Crash



In a continuation of Friday's lead story found <u>HERE</u>, National Transportation Safety Board (NTSB) officials announced they will continue to collect debris from a plane that crashed in Williamson County on Wednesday, resulting in the deaths of three people. The debris field covers a half-mile radius, and collecting all wreckage pieces will take time, according to NTSB spokesperson Aaron McCarter. The plane was en route from Louisiana to Kentucky.

Lucius J. Doucet III was identified as a victim by his medical practice, and Louisiana State University announced the deaths of his children, Giselle and Jean-Luc Doucet. Both were set to graduate from LSU on Friday; Giselle was attending veterinary school, and Jean-Luc was majoring in engineering.

Witnesses reported seeing the plane descending from 10,000 feet to 7,500 feet, with its wings appearing to move backward and the aircraft seemingly out of control. The plane, a Beech Vector 35, manufactured in 1966 and discontinued in the '80s, showed a debris pattern indicative of an in-flight breakup. The NTSB plans to transport the debris to Springfield to reconstruct the event. A preliminary report will be issued 10 days after the NTSB concludes its on-site investigation. Although

the plane did not have a black box, investigators retrieved two memory cards from the scene, which will be analyzed for potential data. So far, 75% of the plane's structure has been recovered, and the search for the remaining parts continues. *Photo Courtesy of The Doucet Family*

**1861** - Kentucky proclaims its neutrality in Civil War

1861 - North Carolina becomes 11th and last state to secede from the Union

1873 - Levi Strauss and Jacob Davis patent the first blue jeans with copper rivets

**1927** - Aviator Charles Lindbergh took off from New York aboard "The Spirit of St. Louis" bound for Paris. He landed 331/2 hours later, completing the first solo non-stop trans-Atlantic flight.

**1932** - Amelia Earhart began the first solo flight by a woman across the Atlantic Ocean, flying from Newfoundland to Ireland in just under 15 hours.

**1942** - During World War II, the Office of Civilian Defense was established.

1974 - Judge John Sirica ordered President Nixon to turn over tapes and other records of 64 White House conversations about the Watergate affair.

1985 - The FBI arrested John A. Walker Jr., who was later convicted of heading a spy ring for the Soviet Union.
