\$20M Loan Approved for Oak Ridge Water Infrastructure



Tennessee Governor Bill Lee and Tennessee Department of Environment and Conservation (TDEC) Commissioner David Salyers announced a \$20 million loan for the City of Oak Ridge to enhance water infrastructure. This loan is part of four approved by the Tennessee Local Development Authority, totaling \$24.7

million, which also includes funds for the Tullahoma Utilities Authority, the City of Winchester, and the Town of Woodbury.

The Oak Ridge loan, provided by the Drinking Water State Revolving Fund Loan Program, will finance the construction of a new membrane filtration water treatment plant. The loan carries a 30-year term with a 3.33 percent interest rate. The State Revolving Fund Loan Program offers communities, utility districts, and water and wastewater authorities lower interest rates compared to private financing, with rates ranging from zero percent to below market rate depending on the community's economic health.

◆ Two men drowned at the Tennessee Riverpark boat ramp in Chattanooga on Saturday evening. It happened when one man fell in and another man jumped in to try to rescue him according to the Chattanooga Fire Department. The two drowning victims were not wearing life vests. Investigators determined that the two men were standing on a floating dock and family members told first responders that one of the men fell into the river and the other victim jumped into the water in an effort to save him. Both victims drowned in 7-10 feet of water surrounding the boat ramp. The two men were identified as 25-year-old Bismar Osveli Castanon and 19 -year-old Axel Adrian Velasquez.

• A criminal suspect with numerous charges was taken into custody on Monday. The Hamilton County Sheriff's Office and the Bradley County Sheriff's office were able to locate the suspect at an address in Bradley County. The 35 year-old-suspect, Ayodeji Olamide Ajayi, refused to surrender to law enforcement. HCSO detectives made contact with the suspect via phone and advised him to surrender. The suspect made statements that he would not surrender, that he had a gun, and that he was going to act in a way that would force law enforcement to kill him. A tense and lengthy standoff ensued, however, HCSO detectives were able to maintain contact with Ajayi and persuaded him to peacefully surrender. Ajayi was found to be in possession of a toy BB pistol that closely resembled a real firearm. He had several active felony warrants and is being charged with: 4 Counts of Aggravated Rape, 1 Count of Rape, Aggravated Burglary, Sexual Battery, Aggravated Kidnapping and Domestic Assault. He was booked into the Hamilton County jail. No bond was listed. Chattanoogan.com
