### Grants Awarded to Meigs, Bradley & Polk



Tennessee Governor Bill Lee and TNECD Commissioner Stuart C. McWhorter announced \$162.7 million in grants for broadband and digital opportunity programs, aiming to provide access to over 236,000 residents in 92 counties. Several multimillion dollar grants have been awarded to Meigs, Bradley and

Polk Counties that will expand broadband availability and are designed to help promote digital skills and workforce development. The state investments will support community-based digital skills training, public Wi-Fi projects, distribution of free or low-cost devices and marketing for low-cost internet plans. The grants are administered by the Tennessee Department of Economic and Community Development (TNECD). A total of almost 10 million dollars will be distributed to various internet service providers in the 3 county area. These grant programs assist with capital expenses related to broadband deployment in unserved and underserved areas of Tennessee. They are part of a broader strategy to ensure every resident has access to high-speed internet by the year of 2028.

#### TN National Guard Rescues Hiker



A UH-60 Blackhawk helicopter and medical flight crew from the Tennessee National Guard recently rescued a hiker suffering from a severe illness in a remote part of the Great Smoky Mountains National Park. Shortly before 7 p.m., the Tennessee National Guard and the Tennessee

Emergency Management Agency were notified of a hiker requiring immediate medical assistance. The hiker was located more than 5,000 feet above sea level, at Icewater Spring. Less than an hour later, a flight crew from the Tennessee National Guard's Task Force Smoky took off from the McGhee-Tyson Air National Guard Base to rescue the hiker. The Blackhawk helicopter arrived on scene about 20 minutes later and quickly performed a hoist rescue to carefully lift the hiker into the aircraft. The crew transported the hiker to the University of Tennessee Medical Center in Knoxville, shortly after 9 p.m. The entire operation, from first notification of a potential mission to patient handoff at the hospital, took about two hours.
