Area Code Changes Coming



Due to high demand for new telephone numbers, the Tennessee Public Utility Commission has approved the addition of the 729 area code to the existing 423 area code region in East Tennessee, which

includes the larger communities like Bristol, Chattanooga, Johnson City, and Kingsport. This is known as an area code overlay.

Starting August 5, 2024, there will be a six-month permissive dialing period during which local calls can be made with either 7 or 10 digits.

Beginning February 5, 2025, all local calls within the 423 area code must be dialed using 10 digits. Calls using only 7 digits will not be completed.

From March 5, 2025, **new** phone lines may receive numbers from the new 729 area code, which will co-exist with the 423 area code, and 10-digit dialing will be required for both.

Current phone numbers and their current area code will not change. This only applies to new phone lines.

Free Fishing Day



The 2024 Bobby Wilson Free Fishing Day will be held this Saturday, June 8, in Tennessee. On this day, residents and visitors of any age can fish for free in the state's public waters without a license. Additionally, youths aged 15 and younger can fish for free for the entire week, from June 8 to June

14. The Tennessee Wildlife Resources Agency (TWRA) has been organizing this annual event since 1991 to introduce children and families to fishing and outdoor activities. To enhance the experience, the agency stocks thousands of pounds of fish across the state. The event is named in honor of Bobby Wilson, who

retired in 2022 after over 40 years with the TWRA. Free Fishing Day and Week are applicable in Tennessee's public waters, TWRA-owned lakes, and state park facilities, but some privately owned pay lakes may still charge fees.
