#### **Update on Calhoun Crash that Killed Two**



Anastasia Balkcom is facing multiple charges after it was discovered she lied about not being the driver in a fatal accident that killed two Cleveland High students. The charges include two counts of vehicular homicide, false reports, vehicular assault, aggravated assault, and driving without due care.

According to an affidavit from the

McMinn County court, the accident occurred on Cherokee Crossing in Calhoun, Tennessee. Troopers found a white Hyundai Santa Fe overturned with two deceased victims, Air'ra Wilson and Shytez Jackson, inside. Balkcom and Jaylen Deandre Wesley-Cook were questioned at the scene.

Wesley-Cook claimed he was driving eastbound at 35 mph when he swerved to avoid an animal, causing the vehicle to roll over. Balkcom supported this story, but the evidence contradicted their accounts. Discrepancies indicated Balkcom was the driver, such as her plea to Wesley-Cook to lie and the driver's seat being adjusted to her height of 5ft 11in.

Sheriff Joe Guy stated that Balkcom has since turned herself in, and the Tennessee Highway Patrol (THP) is investigating the crash. Source: Newschannel9.com

#### Lee Allows Narcan in Schools



Governor Bill Lee signed a bill recently that authorizes a new state law that allows the overdose-reducing drug Narcan into schools. It's one step that might help in the fight against opioid overdoses. The legislation allowing students, staff, and visitors to carry naloxone received bipartisan support. Staff, teachers, and even

students will be able to carry the nasal spray version of Narcan on school grounds. So if an emergency happens, they can save a life. According to the CDC, Tennessee has the second highest overdose death rate in the nation behind West Virginia, and 91% of drug overdoses in young people involve opioids. The FDA allowed the nasal spray version to be sold over the counter last year. It's available at most pharmacies. Healthcare workers say that an accidental dose of Narcan taken by someone wouldn't have any side effects.
