## Tellico Plains Toddler Dead from Apparent Drowning


A 2-year-old girl is dead after being found in a pool at a home in the Tellico Plains area. The Monroe County Sheriff's Office reported that deputies responded to a report of a drowning in the Tellico area at around 1:30 p.m. on Wednesday, June 12. According to MCSO, some children were outside playing when their mother stepped away for a "quick minute." When she returned, the sheriff's office said her 2-year -old daughter was found in a pool at the home. Responders performed CPR on the girl until they arrived at Sweetwater Hospital. At the hospital, medical personnel determined the girl had died. According to the State of Tennessee's 2023 Child Fatality Annual Report, drowning is the leading cause of death in children ages one through four. From: WATE.COM

## TN Dept of Safety & Homeland Security Offers Free Cable Gun Locks

The TN Department of Safety and Homeland Security (TDOS) is providing FREE 15-inch cable locks for securing shotguns, rifles, pistols, and revolvers. These locks prevent firearms from being fired by running through the barrel or action and feature a rubber coating to protect the firearm. They have a secure keyed deadbolt locking mechanism with a 4-pin cylinder. So far, 69,500 gunlocks have been distributed. For enhanced security, it is advised to use these cable locks in conjunction with other safe storage measures, such as locked gun cases, firearm safes, or lock boxes, and to store ammunition in a separate locked container. Keys to the cable lock should be kept in a secure, hard-to-access location. Story Continued on Page 5





## TN Dept of Safety & Homeland Security Offers Free Cable Gun Locks



From page 2: "Safe firearm storage saves lives, and as a gun owner, the safe storage of your firearm is your responsibility," said Department of Safety and Homeland Security Commissioner Jeff Long. "Safe storage can prevent accidental shootings, suicide, and theft. I encourage Tennessee gun owners to use our free gun lock to store their firearm safely."

A new video released by the TDOS commissioner Jeff Long TDOS shows a father teaching his son to safely shoot a gun while a curious younger daughter watches. Wanting to join them, the daughter searches her parents' room and finds a gun they thought was well-hidden. When her father enters and catches her off-guard, she turns and points the gun at him. Shocked but relieved, the father takes the gun away and hugs her. The viewer then sees that the gun had a Safe Store Tennessee cable lock. The father says, "This is why Daddy locks his gun." The video ends with a black screen promoting SafeStoreTN.com, which lists locations in all 95 counties where Tennesseans can obtain a free cable lock. *Photo from TN.gov*
