Murder-Suicide at NHC in Dunlap



shooting at NHC Healthcare Sequatchie in Dunlap, TN on the morning of Monday, July 7, left two people dead. Dunlap Police Chief Randy Phillips reported that one of the victims, a resident of the nursing

home, was shot by her husband, who then took his own life.

The incident occurred at the facility on Dell Trail, and Chief Phillips assured that there was no threat to the public. He added that no other injuries were reported. The names of the individuals involved have not been released, and additional details are currently unavailable.

Hikers Injured After Climbing in Smokies



Officials from Great Smoky Mountains National Park are reminding visitors not to climb rocks near waterfalls after two hikers were seriously injured in a fall last

week.

Rangers responded to an incident at Cataract Falls, a 25-foot waterfall located about 10-15 minutes from downtown Gatlinburg, where two hikers sustained serious injuries. The hikers were transported by helicopter from the Sugarlands Visitor Center to a nearby hospital.

Woman Shot Dead After Fireworks Argument



A man from Rhea County became so upset with his neighbors for shooting off fireworks that he went to their home and fatally shot a woman, according to authorities.

The incident occurred on Saturday on Jordan Lane

in Dayton. According to an affidavit from the Rhea County Sheriff's Office, Troy Cranston Butler "became upset" with his neighbors for shooting fireworks with their children and parents.

Heather Danielle Higgins attempted to break up the argument between Butler and another man when Butler shot her in the chest in the front yard. An ambulance transported Higgins to the nearest hospital, where she later died from her injuries.

Beryl Makes Landfall in Southeast Texas, More Than 2.5 Million Without Power



Hurricane Beryl made landfall on Texas' Gulf coast early Monday morning, according to the National Hurricane Center. At 5 a.m., the hurricane's center made landfall as a Category 1 hurricane near Matagorda, Texas, about 85 miles west-southwest of Houston. By later Monday morning, Beryl was downgraded to a tropical storm with maximum sustained winds of 70 mph as it moved north-northeast at 13 mph.

Beryl is expected to turn northeast Monday night and gain speed, heading over east Texas into the Lower Mississippi Valley and the Ohio Valley over the next two days. Current forecasts predict that remnants of Beryl could bring rain to East Tennessee as early as 10 a.m. this morning. *Photo Courtesy of Surfside Beach, Texas Emergency Services*
