Man Found After Silver Alert



A missing 87-year-old from McMinn County has been found after a Silver Alert was issued. Jack Ballard was found safe on July 8 after being last seen wearing blue plaid pajamas in the area of County Road 804 in Etowah according to the Tennessee Bureau of In-

vestigation. He was described as being 5'9", weighing 175 lbs, bald, with brown eyes. He reportedly has a medical condition that may have impaired his ability to return home safely without assistance.

Knox County Teacher Charged with Assault in Cleveland



A Farragut High School teacher (former Cleveland teacher) was arrested by the Bradley County Sheriff's Office after he assaulted a man who bumped into him at a gas station. According to an affidavit, Jonathan Dycus was at a Circle K when the incident occurred. The man who bumped into Dycus apologized, saying "excuse me," but the affidavit states that Dycus grabbed the man's face and pushed him down, causing him to sprain his ankle.

The man informed deputies that Dycus smelled of alcohol and provided a description of Dycus's vehicle. Surveillance footage reviewed by authorities showed Dycus shoving the victim into a large display inside the gas station convenience store. Dycus attempted to buy several beverages but was denied purchase, according to the affidavit. He has been charged with simple assault.

According to a spokesperson from Knox County Schools, Dycus "worked at Farragut High School during the 2023-24 school year, however, he will not be an employee of Knox County Schools in the 2024-25 school year." Today in History - July 10

1890 - Wyoming was admitted into the Union as the 44th state.

1907 - The famous Grandview Hotel in Athens was struck by lightning and burned. The hotel was nicknamed the 'Red Elephant." It was located near North Jackson Street and Woodward Avenue.

1925 - The John T. Scopes "Monkey Trial" opened in Dayton, TN. Scopes was a teacher who was charged with teaching evolution. He was defended by lawyer Clarence Darrow. Williams Jennings Bryan was a witness for the prosecution. Scopes was found guilty and fined \$100.

1930 - France beat Mexico 4-1 in the first match of soccer's inaugural World Cup tournament in Montevideo, Uruguay.

1960 - John F. Kennedy won the Democratic presidential nomination at the party's convention in Los Angeles.

1991 – After 1,000 years, the Russian people were finally permitted to elect a president. Boris Yeltsin took the oath of office this day, after he had resoundingly defeated the Communist Party candidate.
