Former State Senator Mike Bell Joins State Fire Prevention Office

His career in the legislature included high-profile leadership roles as chairman of the Senate Government Operation

Committee (2012-2018) and the Senate Judiciary Committee (2019-2022). In 2022, He joined the Tennessee Wildlife Resources Agency (TWRA) as the agency's Senior Policy Advisor and Legislative Director. "I know firsthand how the men and women who protect their communities as volunteer firefighters deserve everything we can do to support them, which is why I supported legislative proposals such as the Volunteer Firefighter Equipment and Training Grant Program, as well as the Volunteer Educational Incentive Program. TWU Celebrates Inaugural Class of Executive Graduates



Tennessee Wesleyan University's Spring and Summer 2024 Commencement services celebrated the first graduates of The Goodfriend College of Business and Professional Studies Executive Graduate Program.

With the support of Dr. Robert Goodfriend, TWU Board of Trustees Chairperson, the executive programs were launched in fall 2023 semester. The development of the programs were fueled by a vision to create a learning environment fostering intellectual curiosity, critical thinking, and practical skills. From the outset, they were designed to meet the needs of today's educational landscape. Offered in a low-residency hybrid format, these programs bridge the gap between classroom instruction and practical application. Residency weekends provide a time of study while allowing students to interact with faculty and classmates on TWU's West Knoxville campus.

Executive graduate program students choose from six entry points per year to begin their studies that includes three areas of study: the Master of Business Administration, the Master of Science in Project Management, or the Master of Science in Business Analytics. These programs had their first graduates in May, with another nine students graduating in August. Multiple Indictments in East TN Meth Ring

An investigation by the Tennessee Bureau of Investigation (TBI) and the 5th Judicial District Drug Task Force has led to the indictment of 15 individuals involved in a large-scale methamphetamine distribution operation in Knox County and surrounding areas. The investigation identified Richard Carroll Baker, a member of the Pagans Motorcycle Club, as the ringleader, with fellow member Brian Batson Fox and others assisting in the distribution of illegal narcotics across East Tennessee. A Knox County Grand Jury returned the indictments on July 31st, with 14 of the individuals already arrested. The investigation remains ongoing. *Continued on Page 4*

<u> Today In History - August 9</u>

1945 - The United States exploded a nuclear device over Nagasaki, Japan, instantly killing an estimated 39,000 people. The bombing came three days after Hiroshima was bombed.

1963 - Singer Whitney Houston was born. Her biggest hit records include "The Greatest Love Of All" and "I Will Always Love You."

1969 - Actress Sharon Tate and four other people were found murdered in Los Angeles. Cult leader Charles Manson and a group of his followers known as the "Family" were later convicted of the crime.

1974 - President Richard Nixon's resignation became effective at noon, and Vice President Gerald Ford was sworn in as the nation's 38th President.

2014 - Michael Brown, an unarmed African American teenager, was fatally shot by a white police officer in Ferguson, Missouri, resulting in days of civil unrest and protests fueled by tensions between Ferguson's predominantly Black population and its predominantly white government and police department.
