### **Athens Man Arrested in Major Drug and Weapons Bust**

On Wednesday, August 7, a large-scale search was conducted at the Athens, Tennessee residence of Daniel Lance Buis and a related storage unit. Authorities discovered approximately 540 grams of methamphetamine, 41 firearms (including four reported stolen), three improvised explosive devices, over \$40,000 in cash, and drug paraphernalia. The operation was the result of a joint investigation involving multiple law enforcement agencies, including the 10th Judicial Drug Task Force, Athens Police, McMinn and Monroe County Sheriff's Offices, Sweetwater Police, and the Tennessee Bureau of Investigation. The ATF was called in to assist with the explosives. Buis was arrested and faces charges including possession of methamphetamine for resale, unlawful possession of firearms, possession of explosive devices, and maintaining a drug dwelling. All suspects are presumed innocent until proven guilty in a court of law.





### **Gas Prices See Slight Decrease in Aftermath of Debby**



slightly to \$3.45, mirroring prices seen in June. Gasoline demand has fallen, while domestic gasoline stocks and crude oil production have risen, with crude output

reaching a record 13.4 million barrels per day. These trends suggest that pump prices may continue to decline. Meanwhile, the cost of charging electric vehicles remains stable, with the national average for a kilowatt -hour at Level 2 commercial charging stations holding steady at 34 cents.

"With Tropical Storm Debby going through the I-95 corridor impacting the Mid-Atlantic and Northeast, the threat to Gulf Coast oil production and refining is over," said Andrew Gross, AAA spokesperson. "But tensions in the Middle East and some overseas economic uncertainty may mitigate any drop in oil prices."

The national average for a gallon of gas has decreased Tennessee is now the 2nd least expensive gasoline market in the nation with an average price of \$3.03, seeing the 3rd largest weekly change, a lessening of 7 cents. The McMinn County average is \$2.94. Graphic and data provided by AAA
