1483 - The Sistine Chapel was consecrated by Pope Sixtus IV, dedicating it to Our Lady of the Assumption.

1620 - The Mayflower sets sail from Southampton, England, carrying 102 pilgrims headed for the New World.

1824 - Freed American slaves establish Liberia on the West African coast through the American Colonization Society (ACS)
