Four Arrested at Sweetwater Walmart in connection to Stolen Vehicle, Alabama Crimes



On Thursday, August 22, Sweetwater Police officers apprehended four individuals in connection with a stolen vehicle at the local Walmart. The vehicle, a black Chevrolet Camaro, was reported stolen out of Alabama.

Officers identified two male suspects who had left the Camaro in the parking lot and entered the store. The men later joined two female companions in a white Nissan Altima. All four individuals were detained for questioning.

Upon investigation, it was revealed that the two males, convicted felons from Alabama, were each in possession of a firearm. Further inquiries uncovered that one of the men was wanted for questioning regarding a serious home invasion in Eufaula, Alabama, during which a victim was shot multiple times.

The four suspects now face multiple charges, including weapon offenses, theft, driving violations, and possession of drug paraphernalia.
