

## TN National Guard Fighting Fires in Great Smoky Mountains



The Tennessee National Guard is assisting in efforts to fight wildfires in the Great Smoky Mountains National Park. A wildfire, named the Flint Gap Fire, is near Hannah Mountain, south of Abrams Creek. The fire was first reported to the park on the evening of August 26. The TN National Guard provided four UH-60 Blackhawk helicopters from Knoxville's

1-230th Assault Helicopter Battalion. The helicopters left McGhee Tyson Air National Guard Base with Bambi Buckets used to provide hundreds of gallons of water to fight wildfires. On August 28, three helicopters flew 40 missions delivering 8,000 gallons of water to suppress the fire. The Guard shared that they are prepared to continue supporting the firefighting efforts as long as needed.

### **Vols Beat Mocs 69 - 3**

Tennessee kicked off its 2024 season with a commanding 69-3 victory over Chattanooga at Neyland Stadium, amassing 718 yards of total offense. Quarterback Nico Iamaleava led the charge, throwing for 314 yards and three touchdowns in just two quarters, setting a school record for yardage in a half. The Vols' defense held Chattanooga to only 227 total yards and prevented them from reaching the end zone for any touchdowns. Tennessee scored on 10 of their 13 offensive possessions, marking one of the most dominant performances in the program's history. Iamaleava was exceptional, completing 22-of-28 passes. Running back Dylan Sampson added three rushing touchdowns, and wide receiver Dont'e Thornton Jr. caught two TD passes, contributing to Tennessee's 45-0 halftime lead.

The Vols will face No. 24/22 NC State this Saturday in the Duke's Mayo Classic. Tennessee heads to the Bank of America Stadium in Charlotte. Kickoff is scheduled for 7:30 pm with TV coverage on ABC.
