Yet Another Threat at Area School

The Athens City Middle School received a threat that was posted on social media sometime late Wednesday night or early Thursday morning. Law enforcement personnel were contacted immediately. Athens City Schools Director, Joe Barnett, issued the following statement: "Thank you for your patience and support as authorities have discovered the source and taken appropriate legal steps in regard to the specific threat at the middle school that caused today's (Thursday) disruption. As always, we will investigate every threat in collaboration with local law enforcement and homeland security. Be assured appropriate legal and school disciplinary action will be taken. We hope this current trend of threats being experienced in many districts and states will end and help us to refocus on educating our students in a safe and nurturing environment." Director Barnett told The Morning Fax that nobody was harmed or injured on Thursday.


