FOUR COUNTS OF ATTEMPTED MURDER

Officers with the Athens Police Department investigated a shooting incident which occurred around 10:00 am Saturday, according to sources, in or near the parking lot of North Athens Baptist Church on Tellico Avenue. Two victims (who through other sources have been identified as teen-aged girls) have been transported to area medical facilities and are receiving treatment. One of the victims, a 15 year old girl, received 2 gunshot wounds to her leg. One person has been taken into custody and charged with 4 counts of attempted murder. He was identified as 27-year-old Shyheim Benton of Athens and is in the McMinn County Jail under a \$500,000 bond. APD says that other persons of interest are actively being sought for questioning. 43rd Governor of TN Passes Away at 97



Former Tennessee Governor Winfield Dunn passed away peacefully Saturday, September 27th at the age of 97, surrounded by family, according to an announcement from Governor Bill Lee's office. Born on July 1, 1927, in Meridian, Mississippi, Dunn served in both the U.S. Navy during World War II and as a reserve lieutenant in the U.S. Air Force. He graduated from the University of Mississippi in 1950, the same year he married his wife, Betty, before earning

his D.D.S. at the University of Tennessee Medical Units in Memphis, where he later practiced dentistry.

Dunn made history in 1970 as Tennessee's first Republican governor in 50 years, despite having never held public office before. During his tenure, he established a statewide kindergarten program, enhanced the state's highway infrastructure, created public parks, and formed the Department of Economic and Community Development. He also chaired the University of Tennessee Board of Trustees and the Tennessee State Board of Regents.

Dunn is remembered for his strong faith, deep love for his family, and dedicated service to the people of Tennessee. His legacy as a unifying and civil leader continues to resonate throughout the state.


