#### Fire Destroys Athens Repair Shop



A garage fire erupted on County Road 659 in Athens around 6 PM Monday evening, following a loud explosion. The resident of the home reported hearing the boom and discovering the garage, which was used as an auto repair shop, engulfed in flames. Several propane and compressed gas cans exploded during the fire.

### **TDOT Strike Force Dispatched**

According to information from the TN Dept. of Transportation, Many East Tennessee roads have been impacted as a result of the storm:

"The damage in East Tennessee is vast," TDOT stated in a Sept. 29 release. Damage statistics on state roadways as of midday Sunday, September 29 showed that:

27 state roadway sections closed 14 state bridges closed Five state bridges destroyed

TDOT's Strike Force team and bridge inspection crews have been dispatched to East Tennessee to assist with recovery and repairs following historic flooding caused by Hurricane Helene, TDOT stated on Sept. 29. "Our Strike Force team is a specialized group that can deploy quickly in a disaster with the equipment needed," TDOT stated. "This team is made up of emergency responders, engineers, and transportation experts who work to remove debris and ensure public safety. The goal of this team is to provide immediate relief and begin the recovery process in flood-affected communities."


