### Earthquakes in Niota

Two earthquakes struck the Niota area on Saturday. The first occurred at 8:03 p.m. and was measured at a magnitude of 2.1. It was located 2.5 miles East Northeast of Niota with coordinates of 35.524N 84.504W. According to the U.S. Geological Survey, it was at a depth of 9.3 miles.

The second earthquake struck less than a minute later and was measured at a magnitude of 1.7. The location was 2.7 miles East Northeast of Niota with coordinates of 35.523N 84.499W. The USGS said this earthquake was at a depth of 8.7 miles.

Earthquakes at these magnitudes usually don't cause major property damage or injuries. However, anyone in the proximity of both of them would likely feel the ground shaking and possibly hear a loud noise similar to a nearby shotgun blast.



### **Etowah Man Charged after Shots Fired**

An Etowah man is facing charges of Attempted Murder, Reckless Endangerment, and Possessing a Weapon While Committing a Dangerous Felony after shots were fired into a woman's car on Wednesday night. According to Sheriff Joe Guy, McMinn County deputies received a call of shots fired into a family's vehicle on Hwy 39 E near Englewood around 1040pm Wednesday night. Deputies responded to find Flor Antonia Guzman who reported that she was pulling into her driveway with her son Fabian

Romero Guzman, 23, and her 8 year-old daughter in the car with her when they heard several shots and the right rear window glass was shattered and something struck her arm. Officers were also able to see what appeared to be a slight wound to Ms Guzman's arm and also noticed other damage in the car, as well as what appeared to be a previously fired bullet in the floorboard. Detectives Amber Cook and Kevin Gray responded and continued the investigation as witnesses nearby said they had heard gunshots and saw someone either riding a bicycle or running across Hwy 39 at the Eureka Trail and then what appeared to be a Grey Nissan pickup truck leaving the scene. *Continued on Page 5*

### **Etowah Man Charged after Shots Fired**

"Ms Guzman stated that she had recently broken off a relationship with a coworker, Keith M. Jackson, 54, of Hoffman St in Etowah, who she said had previously damaged her vehicle and had acted in a threatening way toward her when she tried to break the relationship off. She also said he drove a truck similar to the one witnesses had described," said Sheriff Guy. "So our officers established Mr. Jackson as a person of interest and they along with and Etowah Police officers began looking for the vehicle so we could speak to Mr. Jackson."

Within the hour, Etowah Police made contact with the suspect's vehicle and were able to stop it on County Road 890 east of Etowah, where they were joined by McMinn County deputies. As the officers spoke with Keith M. Jackson, deputies noticed a loaded handgun in Mr. Jackson's vehicle. Jackson, a convicted felon, was placed under arrest.

"Deputies seized the truck, and the detectives obtained a search warrant for the vehicle," said Sheriff Guy. "Upon executing the search warrant, the firearm was recovered and evidence suggested it had recently been fired. A bicycle was also located in the rear of the truck." Keith M. Jackson was arrested on 3 counts of attempted murder, felony reckless endangerment, and possessing a firearm while committing a dangerous felony, and was booked into the McMinn Co Jail on \$262,000 bond.


