Today is the Final Day of Early Voting



On Wednesday, Secretary of State Tre Hargett issued one final reminder that the early voting period in Tennessee officially ends today — Thursday, Oct. 31.

"If you have made your electoral decision go ahead and cast your ballot. Don't risk not being able to get to the polls on Election Day. Head to the polls today and vote," said Secretary Hargett.

Through the first 11 days, more than 1.7 million voters have already cast their ballot, including an in-person turnout of more than 1.64 million, which outpaces 2020 in-person numbers. Those voting

early or on Election Day should remember to bring valid photo identification to the polls. A driver's license or photo ID issued by the Tennessee Department of Safety and Homeland Security, Tennessee state government, or the federal government can be used even if they are expired. College student IDs are not acceptable. Tennessee remains number one in the nation in election integrity for the third consecutive year; registered voters can find hours and polling locations, view sample ballots, and more by download-

TN to Invest \$101.6M in Broadband Expansions



Gov. Bill Lee and TNECD Commissioner Stuart C. McWhorter announced on Wednesday that Tennessee will invest \$101.6 million in broadband and digital opportunity grants to expand internet access and digital resources for over 97,000 residents in 75 counties. This funding brings TNECD's total commitment to broadband infrastructure to \$683 million, connecting 700,000 Tennesseans across 280,000 locations.

The grants focus on enhancing high-speed internet access and digital literacy, with completion set for December 2026. The \$34.5 million Last Mile grants will expand broadband in six counties, while \$67.1 million in digital oppor-

tunity grants will equip 3 million Tennesseans with skills for high-paying digital jobs. Additional funding supports local government projects, virtual health, education, and digital skills training across the state.

Sweetwater PD Drug Bust on Friday



On Friday, October 25, the Sweetwater Police Department, in collaboration with the 10th Judicial Drug Task Force, executed a search warrant at a residence in the 200 block of Oakland Road, concluding a thorough investigation into suspected narcotics distribution. Officers seized 65 grams of methamphetamine, drug paraphernalia, and

U.S. currency. James Viar was arrested and will face charges related to the incident. The department issued a warning to anyone involved in drug activities, stating, "We... want to remind anyone that is involved in selling narcotics in Sweetwater, we will be at your door next."
