Vacant Home Destroyed in Delano Fire



A vacant home on Ashley Drive in Delano was destroyed in a fire early Tuesday morning. West Polk Fire Department requested mutual aid from Etowah Rural Fire,

Etowah City Fire, and Englewood Rural Fire Departments to combat the blaze.

The house was already a total loss by the time mutual aid units arrived. Additional assistance came from AmeriPro, the Polk County Sheriff's Department, and EUB.

West Polk Operations Chief Keith Jeskee commanded the scene. The cause of the fire remains under investigation.

MRHS Discounting Adoption Fees for the Holidays



What is the Likelihood of Tennessee Hosting a CFP Game?



Entering Week 13 of the college football season, Tennessee has moved up three spots to No. 8 in the College Football Playoff (CFP) rankings after pivotal upsets by Florida, Oklahoma, and Ohio State. If the current trajectory holds, the Volunteers would secure the No. 9 seed in the CFP's 12-team format. However, one more jump in the rankings could allow Tennessee to host a first-round playoff game.

To keep their hopes alive, Tennessee must defeat Vanderbilt in their regular-season finale to secure a 10-2 record. Beyond that, a few key scenarios could boost their ranking:

- 1. Southern Cal upsetting No. 5 Notre Dame: A loss would drop the Fighting Irish to 10-2 with a less impressive résumé.
- 2. Texas A&M beating No. 3 Texas: A Longhorns loss could lead to a rankings shake-up, although their placement relative to Tennessee would depend on quality wins.
- 3. Outcome of the SEC Championship Game: In years past, the CFP selection committee has been known to drop the loser of the SEC Championship from the CFP rankings. Whether it's Texas A&M, Georgia, or Texas, either falling off would benefit Tennessee in the playoffs.

If Texas A&M advances to the SEC Championship and defeats Georgia, complications arise, as both teams would likely remain ahead of Tennessee. Ideally, the Aggies would lose to Georgia in Atlanta, keeping Tennessee in contention as the second-highest-ranked SEC team.

While less likely, an upset of Penn State by heavy underdog Maryland would also help Tennessee's case. First, however, the Vols must focus on Vanderbilt. Kickoff is set for noon ET this Saturday, as Tennessee looks to solidify its playoff aspirations. The broadcast airs on ABC Television.
