

National Gas Prices Plunge to **Three-Year Low**

The national average for a gallon of gas has dropped to \$3.03, just shy of the \$3 mark for the first time since May 2021. While prices have fallen three cents in the past week, the decline has been slow.

AAA reports that 32 states already have averages below \$3, with Hockley County, Texas, posting the lowest at \$2.30. Gasoline demand rose slightly last week, while production decreased, and domestic stocks grew modestly.

Compared to last month, the national average has dropped by seven cents and is 19 cents lower than this time last year. Mean-

Lady Vols Topple Seminoles, Remain Undefeated



Tennessee (6-0) narrowly defeated Florida State (8-2) in a thrilling 79-77 victory Wednesday at the Food City Center in Knoxville, maintaining their perfect season under first-year head coach Kim Caldwell.

Talaysia Cooper led the Lady Vols with 22 points, shooting 10of-17 from the field. Cooper,

Alyssa Latham and Samara Spencer each grabbed seven rebounds, while Spencer and Ruby Whitehorn tallied four assists apiece.

Tennessee showcased team depth with 22 bench points and dominated in the paint with 46 points. They also added 21 points off turnovers, 19 second-chance points, and 16 fast-break points.

Tennessee hits the road for its first game outside of Food City Center, when it travels to Brooklyn, N.Y., to face No. 17 / 20 Iowa on Saturday night in the Shark Beauty Women's Champions Classic. FOX will televise the game from the Barclays Center at 7 p.m. ET, and the Lady Vol Network and SiriusXM will have a radio broadcast and audio streams as well.

Blowout in Championship Games Remain Tennessee's Last Hope to Host



Tennessee's chance to host a College Football Playoff first -round game hinges on decisive outcomes in Saturday's SEC and Big Ten title games. Ranked No. 7 in the latest CFP poll, the Vols (10-2)

would need lopsided losses from No. 5 Georgia (10-2) or No. 3 Penn State (11-1) to move up to No. 6 and secure a home game at Neyland Stadium.

Georgia's 31-17 win over Tennessee earlier this season is a significant head-to-head factor, while Penn State's weaker resume could lead to a drop if Oregon dominates the Big Ten championship. Although the path is narrow, CFP committee chair Warde Manuel stated that results from the title games will determine any ranking shifts. Tennessee is locked into the 12-team playoff, with matchups to be announced Sunday.

First-round games are set for Dec. 20-21 on campus sites, followed by bowl-based quarterfinals and semifinals, culminating in the national championship in Atlanta on Jan. 20. *Photo by: Andrew Nelles / The Tennessean*
