#### Fire Burns Five Acres on Highway 163 in Calhoun



◆ This week on *Hope From the Well*, Connie McIntosh and Robin Nation discuss the "Wonderfully Made Well Banquet." Hope From the Well is heard every Thursday morning at 8:15 a.m. on WYXI RADIO, AM-1390 & FM-94.5.

A fire erupted on the roof ridge of a structure along Highway 163 in Calhoun on Saturday evening, burning approximately five acres before being contained. The cause of the blaze remains undetermined.

Multiple fire departments responded to the scene, including Calhoun Fire, Claxton Fire, Riceville Fire, Athens Rural Fire, Englewood Rural Fire, Etowah Rural Fire, and the Tennessee Division of Forestry. Additional support was provided by AMR and the McMinn County Sheriff's Department.

The operation was led by Calhoun Assistant Fire Chief Justin Evans. Thanks to the coordinated efforts of all involved, the fire was brought under control. Investigations into the fire's cause are ongoing.

#### Authorities Identify Victim in Fatal RV Fire in Madisonville



The Monroe County Sheriff's Office has identified the victim of a fatal RV fire that occurred on Friday, December 6, on Highway 411 in Madisonville. Officials confirmed on Wednesday, December 11, that 71-year-old Sherill Witt tragically lost her life in the blaze.

Emergency responders, including deputies and firefighters from multiple agencies, arrived at the scene in the 6200 block of Highway 411 to combat the fire. The

RV, which was being heated with propane, caught fire, leading to the fatal incident.


Sheriff Tommy Jones initially announced the active fire scene with a fatality on social media shortly after noon on December 6. The exact location of the incident was not immediately disclosed, but investigators from the Criminal Investigation Division were also present.

The sheriff's office has stated that no foul play is suspected in the case. The community mourns this tragic loss.



#### No. 1 Tennessee Defeats Miami 75-62 at Madison Square Garden



In their first game as the nation's No. 1 men's basketball team, the Tennessee Volunteers defeated Miami 75-62 on Tuesday night in the Jimmy V Classic at Madison Square Garden. With the win, Tennessee improved to 9-0 this season.

Fifth-year guard Chaz Lanier led the way with 22 points, including four three-pointers. Tennessee dominated defensively, holding Miami scoreless for the final eight minutes of the first half and forcing multiple turnovers. The Volunteers took a commanding 38-25 lead into halftime and extended their advantage to 18 points early in the second half.

Despite a late push by Miami, Tennessee sealed the win with a strong closing performance led by Lanier, who scored seven points in the final minutes. Sophomore forward Cade Phillips contributed key baskets, and senior forward Igor Miličić Jr. added 16 points and nine rebounds. Senior guard Zakai Zeigler recorded a double-double with 13 points and 10 assists.

Miami's Lynn Kidd led his team with 14 points and 12 rebounds, but the Hurricanes couldn't overcome Tennessee's consistent defense. The Volunteers held Miami to just 39.3% shooting from the field and a 24.2% success rate from beyond the arc.

Now 9-0 for the first time since the 2000-01 season, Tennessee looks ahead to their next challenge against Illinois on Saturday in Champaign. The game will be broadcast live on FOX at 5:30 p.m. ET. **Source: UTSports.com**
