

City of Athens Holiday Collection Schedule and Facility Closures

The City of Athens Public Works Department has announced closures and adjusted garbage collection schedules in observance of Christmas.

Facility Closures:

The Athens Municipal Building, Public Works, Recycle Center, and Animal Shelter will be closed on **Tuesday, December 24**, **and Wednesday, December 25**. Regular business hours will resume on **Thursday, December 26**.

Residential Garbage Collection:

- Monday, December 23 & Tuesday, December 24: Regular schedule
- Wednesday, December 25: Pickup will occur on Thursday, December 26
- Thursday, December 26: Regular schedule
- Friday, December 27: Regular schedule

Residents are reminded to place garbage totes at the road the night before pickup. Extra garbage should be placed **curbside**, **3 feet away from totes** to ensure trucks can properly grasp and empty the totes. Additional garbage will be collected by separate trucks.

Commercial/Industrial Garbage Collection:

- Monday, December 23; Thursday, December 26; Friday, December 27: Regular schedule
- Tuesday, December 24: Limited pickup
- Wednesday, December 25: Pickup will occur on Thursday, December 26, and Friday, December 27
