Morgan Olson is Latest to Announce Layoffs



Morgan Olson, LLC, located at 9600 Corporate Park Drive, Loudon, TN, has issued a WARN (Worker Adjustment and Retraining Notification) notice to the Tennessee Department of Labor and Workforce

Development, stating that 250 employees will be permanently laid off starting February 11, 2025.

The notification was filed on December 18, 2024, with the state's Dislocated Worker Unit. Employees at the facility are not represented by a collective bargaining agreement.

The East Tennessee Human Resource Agency (ETHRA) has activated its rapid response team to work with Morgan Olson and the affected employees. The East Local Workforce Development Board will oversee ongoing support and services, including Rapid Response and Dislocated Worker programs, to assist displaced employees in transitioning to new opportunities.
