Driver Ejected in Rollover Crash on Highway 39






A 2008 Jeep Wrangler traveling east on Highway 39 near County Road 567 in Englewood rolled over after hitting a culvert around 3 p.m. Wednesday. The driver was ejected onto the highway during the crash. Englewood Rural Fire first responders provided initial treatment at the scene before AMR transported the patient to a landing zone set up at Englewood School by Etowah Rural Fire

Department. From there, the patient was airlifted by LifeStar to UT Hospital in Knoxville. Athens Rural Fire, the McMinn County Sheriff's Depart-

contained and further damage prevented. No injuries were reported. *Photo courtesy of Rhonda Murphy - City of Athens Facebook Page*


City of Athens Inclement Weather Schedule


Athens-Isahaya Japan Sister City Committee Offers Free Cultural Lectures


