United Way Accepting Nominations for Community Service Award



Search Warrant Leads to Fentanyl Seizure



On Thursday, January 9, officers and investigators of the Sweetwater Police Dept. executed a search warrant at a residence in the 800 block of Beardshire St. This search warrant followed credible information regarding the sale of fentanyl from the lo-

cation. During the search, officers discovered multiple containers of fentanyl, as well as drug paraphernalia. One individual, identified as Mr. James Ingram, was taken into custody in connection with the investigation. Mr. Ingram now faces charges related to the sale of fentanyl and possession of drug paraphernalia.

Chief Byrum stated "As law enforcement, our primary focus is to stop the sale of dangerous drugs including fentanyl in our community. Every dealer we take down helps save lives and keeps our streets safer."
