

#### **Final Round of Leaf Vacuum Season Announced**

The City of Athens Public Works Department announces that the second and final round of Leaf Vacuum Season began on Monday, January 27. Leaf crews will vacuum leaves placed curbside for pick up until Friday, February 28. After Friday, February 28, leaves must be bagged for pick up. Bagged leaves are picked up throughout the year during junk routes. If you would like your leaves collected during this final round, please rake them three to five feet from the edge of the road. DO NOT PLACE LEAVES IN THE ROAD, IN DRAINAGE DITCH-ES, OR ON SIDEWALK. Doing so creates hazards for motorists and pedestrians, and risks clogging up storm drains that could result in flooding. In areas where there are sidewalks, leaves should be placed behind the sidewalk and leaf crews will pick them up. Also, DO NOT PLACE LEAVES ON OR AROUND OBSTACLES such as mailboxes, trees, fences, poles, yard decorations, water meter lids, and vehicles. Leaf piles around or behind obstacles will not be picked up by the leaf crews, as the leaf vacuum may potentially damage the obstruction or the equipment. #### Three Injured in Collision on Hwy 163 in Delano



A collision occurred Saturday at 5 p.m. on Hwy 163 at Co Rd 968 in Delano, involving a 1999 Dodge 1500 truck and a 2022 Toyota Camry. The driver of the truck was uninjured, but three indi-

viduals in the Toyota required medical attention. Emergency responders from AMR and Monroe County EMS treated the patients at the scene before transporting them to Starr Regional Etowah. Claxton Fire, Etowah Rural Fire, and the McMinn County Sheriff's Department also responded to the incident.

The accident is under investigation by Tennessee Highway Patrol Trooper Tyra Johnson.
