## Starr Regional Medical Center \$12 Million Expansion



Starr Regional Medical Center (SRMC) announced Thursday, January 30<sup>th</sup> the \$12 million expansion of its intensive care unit (ICU) to improve access to critical care services within McMinn County. Construction is estimated to be completed in early 2026. "This is truly an exciting time for Starr Regional Medical Center, the community and the entire region we serve. The project increases our capacity for intensive care patients as well as medical surgical patients," said John McLain, Starr Regional Medical Center Chief Executive Officer. "Our mission is making communities healthier, and it guides everything we do. Enhancing our critical care services and investing in new technology and capabilities to better serve our family, friends and neighbors demonstrates our commitment to this

mission. We will keep the community informed of the project's progress, and we appreciate your patience during the construction process." Starr Regional Medical Center is honored to have been selected as a grant recipient by the Tennessee Department of Health's Healthcare Resiliency Program, a competitive grant program designed to expand Tennessee's capacity in delivering quality healthcare services, as well as modernize and transform healthcare in rural communities across the state. Starr Regional Medical Center was awarded a \$6.4 million grant for the ICU expansion project and Tele-ICU advancement. Once construction is complete, the ICU will occupy the newly constructed space, and the number of ICU rooms will be increased from five to 10 rooms. The unit will feature private rooms, a modernized design and upgraded technology that supports enhanced patient care for the most vulnerable and critical patients, so they can receive the care they need closer to home. The project also will create a new waiting area for families and two additional beds for the medical surgical unit. Starr Regional Medical Center hosted a groundbreaking ceremony on January 29, 2025, to celebrate the beginning of the project. The progress of the ICU expansion project will be shared with community members via the hospital's website and social media channels. ## McMinn Central Sweeps Meigs County in District 3-2A Matchups



McMinn Central Chargers and Chargerettes both picked up district 3-2A wins over Meigs County in Decatur, Tuesday night. Karina Bystry scored the Chargerettes' first 13 points and 18 of the team's first 20 points as Central jumped out to a 24-10 first quarter lead. They stretched the lead to 43-18 at halftime and cruised to a 63-42 victory. Karina Bystry led the Chargerettes with 35 points and moved into 4th place in the career scoring list with 2370 career points passing Julie Aderhold Goodin. Malea Masingale added 13 points. Reagan Baker scored 10 points and led the team with 6 rebounds, 8 assists, and 5 steals. The Chargerettes are now 23-1 overall and 7-0 in district 3-2A.

The Chargers jumped out to a 17-3 lead over Meigs County and led 28-18 at the half. Central outscored the Tigers 24-16 in the third quarter to build an 52-34 lead and pulled away to a 63-42 win. Will Benton led McMinn Central with 23 points and grabbed 7 rebounds. Carter Anderson scored 10 points and grabbed 8 rebounds. Daylen Spradling scored 15 points and led the team with 9 rebounds, 8 assists, and 6 steals. The Chargers are now 8-15 overall and 3-4 in district 3-2A. McMinn Central hosts district foe Kingston Friday. The Chargerettes tip off at 6:00pm.

## TBI Launches New Initiatives to Protect Tennessee's Seniors



The Tennessee Bureau of Investigation (TBI) has introduced two new resources aimed at safeguarding the state's growing senior population.

The first initiative, **TBI Find**, is a mobile app available for Apple and Android devices that provides real-time updates on Silver Alerts in Tennessee. It also offers educational resources and a **CareKit** feature, allowing users to compile and store vital information and photos of loved ones, which can be quickly shared with law enforcement in case of an emergency. While designed for seniors, TBI recommends the CareKit feature for parents of young children as well.

The second initiative, **SafeSeniorTN**, is an online campaign providing guidance on technology, financial safety, and crime prevention for seniors. Hosted at <a href="www.SafeSeniorTN.com">www.SafeSeniorTN.com</a>, the platform combines expertise from TBI's Medicaid Fraud Control Division and Cybercrime Unit to offer tips on avoiding scams, identifying healthcare fraud, and recognizing signs of elder abuse.

TBI officials emphasized the importance of these tools in protecting vulnerable populations and preventing crimes before they occur.
