



Fire Destroys Abandoned Warehouse and Duplex in Etowah



A massive fire broke out at midnight on Tuesday, February 18, at the intersection of 5th Street, County Road 631, and County Road 628 in Etowah. Upon arrival, Etowah City Fire Department found an abandoned warehouse and duplex fully engulfed in flames. The fire spread to a nearby abandoned storage building, which sustained minor fire and smoke damage.

Multiple agencies responded to the scene, including Etowah City Fire Department, Etowah Rural Fire Department, Englewood Rural Fire Department, Athens City Fire Department, and Madisonville City Fire Department. Bradley County Fire Department and West Polk Fire Department stood by at Etowah Rural Fire Department, along with AMR Ambulance and Etowah Utility Board. The exciting times continue for Tennessee Wesleyan Athletics. The basketball programs have had a strong finish to the end of the regular season, the baseball team and the men's and women's tennis teams have had great starts, the seasons for the spring sports have all started. Here are the latest updates:

The baseball program have won six of their last eight games, including wins over No. 17 IU Southeast, Montreat College, and Spartanburg Methodist College. The last win came against Spartanburg Methodist College on Tuesday, a 19-1 win in seven innings. After a 10-strikeout effort on the mound, Justin Jackson of the baseball team was named the Appalachian Athletic Conference Pitcher of the Week.

The men's tennis team, who jumped up to No. 2 in the NAIA rankings, have won their first three AAC matches with 7-0 scores against Johnson University, Truett McConnell University, and Columbia College. The women's tennis team, ranked No. 7 in the NAIA, are on a four-match winning streak after 7-0 wins against Johnson University and Truett McConnell University and a 6-1 win against Columbia College.

Both basketball programs have qualified for the upcoming AAC Tournament, set for Feb. 26-March 1 in Kingsport, Tenn. Seeding has not been finalized yet.

The indoor track and field programs won four individual conference titles at the AAC Championships. The men's team were the winners of the 4x800m Relay and the Long Jump while the women's program won the High Jump and 60m Hurdles. The teams are sending four individuals to the NAIA National Championship Meet. Ke'Andrae Campbell and KT Buchanan both qualified in the Men's 60m Dash, Dakota Caldwell will compete in the

Men's 3000m Race Walk and Samantha DeGrace will compete in the Women's High Jump.

Six individuals were inducted into the Tennessee Wesleyan University Athletics Hall of Fame as a part of the 2024 Class. Amy Brackett (Softball), John Ferguson (Men's Basketball), Josh Lindstrom (Baseball), Curtis Blair (Men's Soccer), Greg Vandagriff (Football), and Toby Brooks (Coach for Softball and Volleyball) are the newest members of the Hall of Fame. The 2024 Team of Honor was the 2005 Softball Team.

Landyn Sanders was named the Mid-South Conference Men's Bowling Bowler of the Year while John Brooks was named the MSC Men's Bowling Freshman of the Year.
