METCC to hold benefit concert for St. Mark AME Zion Church next week



The Mid-East Tennessee Community Chorus (METCC) will present a special benefit concert titled "Beauty for Ashes" on Tuesday, May 6, 2025, at 7:00 p.m. at Allen Memorial United Methodist Church, located at 800 Decatur Pike, Athens, TN.

The concert aims to support St. Mark AME Zion Church, a historic congregation in Athens' Free Hill community that was devastated by fire on August 15, 2024. The blaze not only destroyed the 150-year-old church building but also resulted in a tragic fatality. The cause of the fire and the identity of the victim remain under investigation.

St. Mark AME Zion Church has stood as a cornerstone of the **African-American community** in Athens for more than a century and a half. Located in **Free Hill**, an area historically settled by free Black families, the church has been both a spiritual and cultural hub for generations. Its destruction has left a profound impact on the congregation and surrounding community, who are now facing the difficult path of mourning, healing, and rebuilding.

The "Beauty for Ashes" concert will feature uplifting choral selections and inspirational music, reflecting both the sorrow of loss and the hope of renewal. **Donations will be accepted** at the event, with all proceeds going toward the recovery and restoration efforts for the St. Mark congregation.

Driver Injured After Vehicle Leaves Road and Strikes Ditch in McMinn County



A single-vehicle accident occurred Wednesday afternoon around 2:30 p.m. on County Road 422 near Athens, involving a 2015 Dodge Caravan. According to authorities, the vehicle left the roadway and struck a ditch, resulting in injuries to the driver.

Emergency medical personnel from AMR responded promptly to the scene and transported the driver to Starr Regional Medical Center in Athens for treatment. The extent of the driver's injuries has not been released at this time.

Multiple local agencies responded to assist, including the McMinn County Sheriff's Department, Niota Rural Fire Department, and Englewood Rural Fire Department. The Tennessee Highway Patrol is leading the investigation into the crash, with Trooper Travis Ryans serving as the investigating officer.

Starr Regional Health Officials Urge Measles Vaccination as Cases Rise in Tennessee

Starr Regional Medical Center's Infection Preventionist, Jessica Felker, MSN, RN, CIC, is urging McMinn County residents to take steps to protect themselves against measles as new cases continue to appear across the country, including in Tennessee.

Measles is not just a rash—it's a highly contagious respiratory illness that can lead to severe complications such as pneumonia, brain damage, and even death, especially in babies, young children, and unvaccinated individuals. It spreads easily through coughing and sneezing and remains one of the most contagious viruses known.

The best protection? The **MMR vaccine**. Two doses are recommended for children—one between 12 and 15 months, and a second between ages 4 and 6. Adults born after 1957 who haven't been vaccinated should also get one or two doses.

Vaccination not only protects individuals but also helps shield vulnerable community members who can't be immunized. Felker emphasizes, "It only takes a few seconds to receive a vaccine, but it could save a life."




