Claxton, Riceville, and Athens Rural Fire Departments were dispatched to a single-vehicle rollover at County Road 700 near County Road 674 on Monday around 5:30 p.m. Claxton and Riceville units responded, with Riceville Fire Chief Brandon Ainsworth taking incident command.

When crews arrived, they found the vehicle overturned but no occupant at the scene. Authorities believe the driver had fled the area before first responders arrived.
