Barn Fire Erupts near County Line Friday Afternoon

Fire crews from three departments responded late Friday afternoon to a barn fire that sent thick black smoke billowing across the countryside near the McMinn–Loudon County line.


Units were dispatched around 4:30 p.m. to County Road 296 after multiple reports of heavy smoke in the area. When fire-fighters arrived, they discovered a barn fully engulfed in flames on Blue Springs Road, just off Slabtown Road — technically located in Loudon County.

According to officials, the property owner was not present at the time. A Loudon County Fire official later confirmed that a burn permit had been issued for the property. By the time fire units arrived, the structure had already collapsed.

Responding departments included North McMinn, Clearwater, and Niota Fire Departments. Command of the scene was led by North McMinn Rural Fire Chief Stephen Capua. No injuries were reported.
