A Soulful Christmas is a festive holiday concert with the heart of Gospel and the groove of R&B; this is a celebration of love, community, and the soulful sounds of the season.


Featured performers include Joshua Bragg, Abriel Hardaway, Ashley Espey, and Angel Hardaway. Special guest performances will be announced soon.

# **Driver Hospitalized After Truck Overturns** on County Road 405



A 69-year-old man was taken to a local hospital Thursday morning after his 2020 Chevy Colorado overturned in a crash on County Road 405.

The accident occurred around 10:30 a.m. in the 300 block when the driver lost control on a curve, causing the truck to leave the roadway and land on its side in a

ditch. Firefighters performed an extrication to remove the driver from the vehicle.

The patient was transported by AMR ambulance to a nearby hospital for treatment. Responding agencies included the Niota Fire Department, Englewood Fire Department, McMinn County Sheriff's Department, and AMR. Austin Smith with the Englewood Fire Department served as incident command.


