#### Firefighters, Paramedics Rescue Victim from Englewood House Fire



Fire departments responded to a structure fire on North Amhurst Place in Englewood around 3 p.m. Monday.

An AMR ambulance traveling south on N. Amhurst Place came upon the scene and was informed that someone was trapped inside the burning home. Without hesitation, AMR Paramedic Chris Weddington and AEMT Keith Jeskee entered the structure, pulled the victim to safety, and began advanced life-saving treatment. The patient was later transported to UT Medical Center in Knoxville.

The home sustained heavy fire damage in the utility room, with significant heat and smoke damage throughout the rest of the structure. Tragically, 16 dogs perished in the fire.

Responding agencies included Englewood Rural Fire Department, Etowah Rural Fire Department, Athens City Fire Department, Madisonville City Fire Department, Englewood Police Department, and Athens Utilities Board (AUB). Englewood Rural Fire Chief Billy Roach was in command of the scene.

Those accused are considered innocent until proven guilty in a court of law.



The Certificate of Achievement represents the highest form of recognition in governmental accounting and financial reporting. To receive this award, the City must produce a report that is easily readable, efficiently organized, and satisfies many requirements, standards, and principles. The City's report was reviewed by an impartial panel of judges that included individuals with experience in public sector accounting such as auditors, accountants, and other finance professionals. Out of 345 municipalities in Tennessee, Athens is among only 30 to earn this prestigious recognition.
