Rollover Crash on Highway 307 Injures Driver



A single-vehicle rollover on Highway 307 led to a second crash minutes later on Wednesday afternoon, according to first responders.


The initial accident occurred around 3:35 p.m., when a Nissan Rogue traveling south near County Road 364 dropped off the right side of the roadway. The driver overcorrected, causing the vehicle to cross the road, strike a ditch on the left side, and flip. A 24-year-old male occupant was evaluated at the scene by EMS but was not transported.

As crews prepared to clear the scene, a second accident occurred just north of the first, near County Road 362 on Highway 307. Further details on that crash appear on page 2. of Today's *Morning Fax*.

Two Injured in Serious Crash on Hwy. 307 in Niota

Two people were airlifted to UT Medical Center in Knoxville after a serious crash on Highway 307 near County Road 364 in Niota late Wednesday afternoon.


According to first responders, the driver of a 1982 Dodge Ram approached an existing accident scene (see Page 1) around 5 p.m. and was unable to stop. The truck left the roadway, went down an embankment, and crashed head-on into a culvert. The driver was ejected from the vehicle, and the passenger was partially ejected. *Neither was wearing a seatbelt.*

Emergency crews treated both patients while continuing to manage the earlier accident. The individuals were transported by AMR to LifeStar and LifeForce helicopters, which landed at Mt. Harmony Baptist Church before flying both patients to UT Medical Center. Niota Rural Fire, Englewood Rural Fire, and Athens Rural Fire responded to the scene. The crash is being investigated by THP Sgt. Gordon Roberts.
