#### McMinn County Freshman Rachel Hurst Earns Statewide "League of Extraordinary Teens" Honor



In her "spare time", Rachel is an active member of East Athens Baptist Church and a competitive dancer with Miss Lisa's Dance Studio. The League of Extraordinary Teens is a statewide initiative to engage Tennesseans ages 13-19 in the financial and logistical support of Imagination Library programs in their counties. League Membership requires teens to personally register children and raise funds to cover the cost of including those children in their county's Imagination Library for one full year.

Rachel spent most of the day at the PumpkinTown Festival searching for new parents and young children to enroll in the Dolly Parton Imagination Library Program. Then, she began making potholders to sell to subsidize those new enrollees. She
