## Multi-Agency Search Warrant Leads to Recovery of Stolen Property, Drugs, and Weapons



A multi-agency investigation led to the recovery of stolen property, illegal drugs, firearms, and explosives following the execution of a search warrant earlier this week.

On Monday, Jan. 12, investigators with the McMinn County Sheriff's Office and the 10th Judicial District Drug Task Force, with assistance from the Monroe County Sheriff's Office, executed a search warrant at

a residence in Tellico Plains. During the search, officers recovered items reported stolen in a recent theft in McMinn County.

In addition to the stolen property, authorities seized methamphetamine, marijuana, firearms, and explosives from the residence. A suspect was arrested in Monroe County by the Drug Task Force. Charges related to the investigation are pending in McMinn County.

McMinn County Sheriff Joe Guy praised the cooperation between agencies in addressing criminal activity that crosses jurisdictional boundaries.

"We appreciate the ongoing cooperation between our agencies to resolve crimes across county lines," Guy said. "Criminals don't worry about county lines and city limits, and when it comes to investigating crimes, neither do we."

The investigation remains ongoing.

## AACA Brings Back Our Three Tenors for 'Seasons of Love' Valentine's Concert

The Athens Area Council for the Arts will welcome back a popular musical event this winter with **Our Three Tenors in *Seasons of Love***, scheduled for Friday and Saturday, Feb. 13–14, 2026. The concert marks the fourth installment of AACA's 2025–26 House Blend Concert Series.

Directed by Kay Simmons and Pam Thigpen, the program features Tim Frazier, Rusty Patterson and Mike Simmons in their first full-length performance together in more than five years. *Seasons of Love* celebrates love in all its forms through a mix of audience favorites, Great American Songbook classics, show tunes and contemporary pop selections.

Simmons, a longtime figure in the Athens music and theatre community, has served as an actor, singer, accompanist and piano teacher and was the founding director of the Athens Area Children's Choir. Thigpen, a retired Athens City Schools music teacher, is also known for directing the popular *Jazzy Little Christmas*.

The Friday, Feb. 13 performance includes light hors d'oeuvres, with tickets priced at \$25. The Saturday, Feb. 14 concert features a full meal, with tickets at \$40. Due to catering arrangements, ticket sales for the Saturday performance will end on Tuesday, Feb. 10. Advance ticket purchases are strongly encouraged, as AACA events often sell out prior to the performance dates.
