Heil Trailer to Invest Nearly \$10 Million in Athens Expansion, Add Jobs Through New Army Contract



Heil Trailer International, one of McMinn County's largest and longest-standing manufacturers, will expand its Athens operations with a nearly \$10 million investment tied to a new U.S. Army contract, bringing new jobs and advanced production capabilities to the community. State and company officials announced this week that Heil Trailer will invest \$9.8 million and create 18 new jobs after securing a 10-year contract with the U.S. Department of the Army to manufacture its Tactical Fuel Distribution System. The expansion will include new warehouse space, automated paint and welding systems, a new testing area, and an expanded welding and training school at the Athens facility.

"Heil Trailer's continued investment in Athens and McMinn County is a testament to the strength of our community and the partnerships that drive economic growth," Athens Mayor Larry Eaton said. "Investments like this not only create jobs but also reaffirm that Athens is a place where businesses can thrive."

The project strengthens Heil's role in national defense manufacturing while modernizing its local operations. Company leaders said the upgrades will support production efficiency and create new opportunities for skilled and technical workers. "EnTrans proudly supports Heil Trailer's TFDS manufacturing program, a milestone initiative that underscores both the strength of our partnership with the U.S. Army and our long-standing commitment to Athens," said Ryan Rockafellow, CEO of EnTrans International, Heil's parent company. "This program represents a monumental win for Heil Trailer, EnTrans and the Athens community."

Founded in 1901, Heil Trailer has operated in Athens since 1977 and will mark its 50th anniversary in Tennessee next year. The company is widely known locally for its tanker and specialty trailer manufacturing and is part of the EnTrans International family of brands, serving customers worldwide. McMinn County Mayor John Gentry said the expansion highlights the quality of the local workforce. "Heil Trailer produces approximately 50 percent of all tankers in the U.S., which means McMinn County's excellence and craftsmanship are on display throughout the nation," Gentry said.

State officials also praised the project as an example of Tennessee's manufacturing strength and pro-business climate, noting the expansion's impact on Southeast Tennessee's economy and workforce.. *Source: TN ECD*

Human Remains Found Near Etowah; Investigation Underway



Human remains were discovered Tuesday morning in a wooded area near the Parkstown Community just south of Etowah, according to McMinn County Sheriff Joe Guy. The remains were found around 11:30 a.m.

The Tennessee Bureau of Investigation is leading the investigation with assistance from the McMinn County Sheriff's Office. Sheriff Guy said the discovery may be connected to a local man who recently left his home in the area and did not return, though officials emphasized that the remains must undergo testing before a positive identification can be made.

The investigation remains ongoing. "Anytime someone is found like this, we want to be conscious of the family members and friends who might be affected," Sheriff Guy said. "They are certainly in our prayers."

Medical Emergency Leads to Interstate Crash in McMinn County



A medical emergency is believed to have caused a single-vehicle crash Wednesday afternoon on the interstate in McMinn County.

At approximately 4:30 p.m., a 2016 Nissan Rogue traveling southbound near the 59-mile marker left the roadway after the 70-year-old male driver experienced a medical issue. The vehicle ran off the right side of the interstate, struck trees along the embankment, and rolled over.

The driver, who was the sole occupant of the vehicle, sustained minor injuries and was transported to Sweetwater Hospital by AMR ambulance as a non-emergency.

North McMinn Fire, Niota Rural Fire, and AMR responded to the scene. The Tennessee Highway Patrol is investigating the crash, led by Trooper Andrew Metelits.
