All 14 Labor and Delivery Nurses Resign Following Sweetwater Hospital Unit Closure Announcement



All 14 nurses employed in the Sweetwater Hospital Association's (SHA) Labor and Delivery Department have submitted their two-week notices following the hospital's decision to close the unit.

SHA announced late last week that the Labor and Delivery Department will close on February 28, citing difficulties in maintaining specialty provider coverage along with financial challenges related to low reimbursement rates, rising operational costs, and declining patient volumes.

In a resignation letter obtained by 6 News, the nurses stated that a "significant breakdown in trust" led to their decision, adding that they no longer felt they could effectively function as employees of SHA.

Sarah Ortez, a nurse who has worked at SHA for 20 years, described the closure as devastating and deeply disappointing in a statement to 6 News. Ortez expressed concern for expectant mothers in the region, noting that many women may be unable to travel one to two hours to reach another hospital once labor begins. She warned that longer travel times could increase risks for both mothers and babies, potentially leading to more emergency deliveries at home, in vehicles, or in emergency rooms not equipped for child-birth.

The Sweetwater Hospital Labor and Delivery Department served patients from parts of Meigs, McMinn, Roane, and Loudon counties, as well as all of Monroe County.
