Suspect in Fatal Shooting Captured in Bradley County



A man wanted in connection with a fatal shooting in Athens Wednesday afternoon has been arrested following an extensive search involving local, state, and federal agencies.

The Athens Police Department began investigating after officers responded to reports of gunfire near Tell Street and Howard Street. Two men were found with gunshot wounds. One victim, who was conscious at the scene, was transported to a local hospital and later transferred to another facility. The second man was pronounced dead on the scene by EMS. His name has not yet been released.

Based on evidence, investigators identified Carlos Alejandro Quintana, a younger Hispanic male with multiple tattoos, as a person of interest. Authorities warned the public that Quintana was armed and dangerous. Another suspect has been identified, though their name has not been released.

The shooting prompted Athens City Schools and McMinn County Schools to go on "Secure" status as officers searched the area. Multiple agencies assisted in the initial response and search, including the Tennessee Highway Patrol, Rhea County K-9 Unit, Athens Fire Department, McMinn County Sheriff's Office, AMR, the District Attorney's Office, and the FBI.

Following the incident, a coordinated effort between the U.S. Marshals Service, Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms and Explosives, Tennessee Bureau of Investigation, Drug Task Force, Bradley County Sheriff's Office, Athens Police Department, and McMinn County Sheriff's Office led to

Quintana being located at a residence in northeast Bradley County. Deputies with the Bradley County Sheriff's Office took him into custody without incident and transported him to the McMinn County Justice Center to face charges related to the shooting.

Authorities praised the cooperation between agencies for ensuring the suspect's swift capture without harm to the public. The investigation remains active, with an increased law enforcement presence expected in Athens in the coming days.


Ribbon Cutting Held for Weichert Realtors The Space Place
