

City of Athens officials are preparing for a possible winter weather system expected to impact the area this weekend, with crews taking proactive steps to protect public safety and maintain essential services.

Public Works crews are scheduled to begin applying brine and salt to roadways on Friday to reduce the risk of icy and hazardous driving conditions. Snowplows and related equipment are being inspected and positioned for rapid deployment if needed. City officials said Athens is also coordinating with McMinn County and state emergency management agencies to ensure a unified response should conditions worsen.

Emergency services will remain fully operational on a 24-hour basis throughout the event, and residents are urged to contact McMinn County E-911 in the event of an emergency.

City officials encourage residents to stay informed by monitoring updates posted on the City of Athens website and official social media channels. Citizens are also encouraged to register for the McMinn County Emergency Alert System to receive timely notifications related to weather and public safety.

In addition, the McMinn Warming Center, located at 714 Walter Street in Athens, will be available as an overnight shelter when temperatures fall to 32 degrees or below, providing a safe, warm place for those in need.

City officials thanked the public for their cooperation and urged residents to remain weather-aware and take appropriate precautions as the weekend approaches. *Source: [City of Athens - Facebook](#)*

Monroe County Sheriff's Office Urges Residents to Check on Neighbors During Extreme Cold



As temperatures continue to fall and extremely cold weather is expected through the rest of the week and into the weekend, the Monroe County Sheriff's Office is reminding residents to take time to check on elderly family members, neighbors, and others who may need assistance.

Officials encourage residents to ensure vulnerable individuals have adequate heat, food, medications, and warm clothing. Cold temperatures can be especially dangerous for older adults and those with limited mobility, and even a brief phone call or visit can make a significant difference.

The sheriff's office also urges the public to take precautions to protect themselves and their homes, including the safe use of heating sources and checking on pets and livestock during the cold spell.

Anyone who knows of someone in need of assistance is encouraged to reach out or contact local resources. Officials emphasized that looking out for one another helps keep the community strong and safe during extreme weather.

ACT Presents “Annie” at the Arts Center




Athens Community Theatre (ACT) will bring the beloved, Tony Award-winning musical *Annie* to the stage February 19 through March 1, 2026, as part of its 2025 –26 Mainstage season.
